

Parking and Traffic Standing Committee Meeting

Discussion:

- Linda Christian welcomed the committee members and explained she was filling in for Mike Harris, the committee chair. Linda explained to the members that Mike's practice is:
 - to meet on the second Monday of each month at 3pm in Lyceum 110
 - to email the meeting agenda and minutes of the previous meeting to members a few days prior to the next meeting
 - to encourage members to bring before the committee any of their parking and traffic concerns or those that are passed on to them by co-workers and/or fellow students

Because this was the first meeting of the 2018-2019 school year and there were returning members along with new members in attendance, committee members introduced themselves.

- Due to the lack of quorum in previous meetings, minutes from the April 9, May 14, July 9, and August 13 meetings were submitted for approval. All the minutes were approved by the committee (Dr. Robert Barnard made a motion, seconded by Sarah Doty).
- Dr. George McClellan advised it appears that handicap accommodations have not been taken into account with some campus construction projects. In particular he mentioned the recent project at the front of Guyton Hall. He stated that there are less handicap designated spaces now in front of Guyton than before the project. He also mentioned his experience in attempting to park in handicap parking in connection with his going to Lenoir Hall to patronize Lenoir Dining. He described the challenges in front of Lenoir that involve steep stairs from the street (Sorority Row); and he mentioned he did not see any directional access signage. He said he drove around the area with no success.
